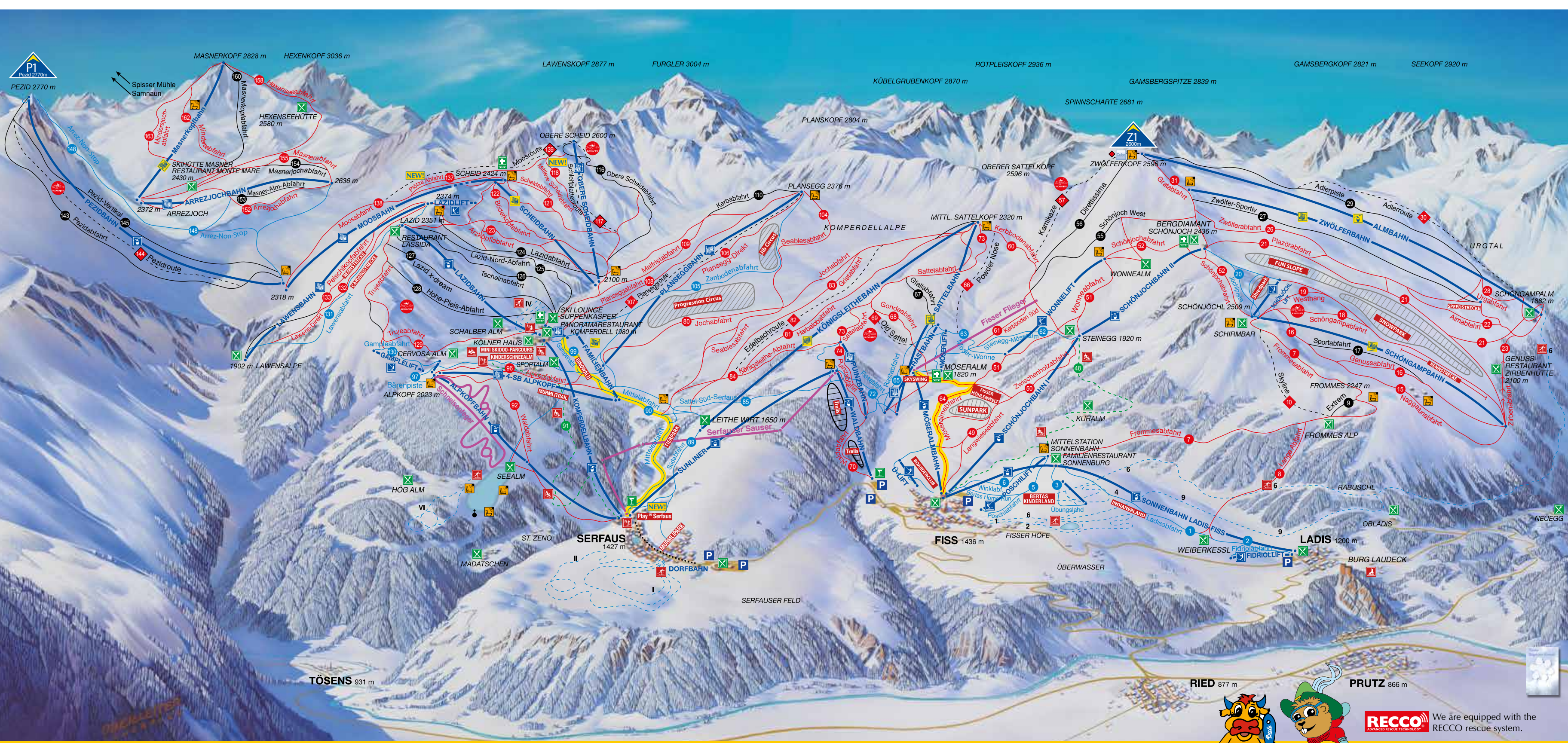

NEWS.

FROMMES II RESERVOIR
With the new construction of the Frommes II Reservoir, the strength of the snow-making facilities was increased fourfold. This means that when the temperatures are low, we will be able to generate considerably more snow in a very short time, also allowing us to put more pistes into operation.

PLAY^{IN} SERFAUS
The new play and climbing world right by the valley terminal of the Komperdellbahn in Serfaus offers everything children could ever dream of: fun games – sports – and all indoors! A huge play & climbing paradise for kids and teens. In the large climbing hall, 11 different climbing walls are available – every line has its own motto. A real highlight are the two geometrix lines – two free-standing climbing towers in the middle of the hall. The Boulder Room next door resembles a large chemistry laboratory, where there's an exciting task to solve! Another favourite is the large soft-play area, which extends over 6 whole floors! A laser room where both skill and speed are required rounds off the perfect play experience at the valley terminal. Adults have their own lounge area with refreshments and snacks available.

ART TRAIL
The recently created “Art Trail” winter hiking trail leads from Schönjoch over Grat to the mountain terminal of the Schöngampbahn. Along the Art Trail, you can find stunning works of art made of various materials such as wood, marble, steel, stone, granite, etc., which were created by renowned artists on Schönjoch as part of the event “Art on the Mountain”, and which can be purchased.

NEW DOWNHILL RUNS/PISTE IMPROVEMENTS
In the area of the Obere Scheid, you can enjoy two new downhill runs from the 2016/2017 winter season: the Mittlere Scheid and the Plötza downhill runs. The Plötza downhill run offers an alternative to the Moos downhill run to reach the Masner ski area. In addition, piste improvements were carried out in the lower part of the Möseralm downhill run.

EXTENSION OF THE SNOWMAKING FACILITIES
Investments in optimising the snow-making performance have also been made again this year, and the entire Obere Scheid can also be covered with artificial snow as of now.

The ski slopes are closed each day from 5.00 pm to 8.45 am! You are not permitted to ski or stay on the slopes during these times.

On Wednesdays the pistes may be used by “First Track” participants from 7.30 am.

Exceptions in Serfaus
The Mittel, Süd and Wald downhill runs are closed from 6.00 pm (except on Wednesdays: Mittel downhill and tobogganing run are closed 5.00 pm – 6.00 pm, open from 6.00 pm – 11.30 pm for “Adventure Night”).

Exceptions in Fiss
Möseralm downhill run open from 6.00 pm – 11.00 pm for nighttime skiing and from 6.00 pm – 10.00 pm on tobogganing evenings.

Piste maintenance and snow-grooming vehicles with winch cables

We occasionally need to deploy piste maintenance machines on the slopes when they are still being used by skiers. Please ensure you keep a safe distance from such machines in the

interests of your own safety. **Please heed acoustic and visual warning signals at all times!**

After pistes close at the end of the day **winch cables from piste maintenance devices** present a potential hazard. The cable car operators accept no liability for accidents! Please note that in the case of persistent snowfall, groomed slopes may once again become snowed over prior to opening so that they may not always be completely frozen. As a result, moguls and piles of snow may form shortly after the ski slopes are in use.

Closure of pistes and avalanche blasting

For safety reasons, avalanche blasting may take place if large amounts of fresh snow have fallen. Detonations usually take place in the early hours before the start of regular ski operations. If there is a particularly large volume of new snow, avalanche blasting may also have to take place while the slopes are being used by skiers. The affected areas are then closed for skiing! Watch out for information at stations and terminals!

Backcountry skiing

If you intend to go skiing outside the secured area you are advised in the interests of your own safety to find out about the risk of avalanches, any planned avalanche blasting and weather conditions from the cable car operators.

Tobogganing

Please do not use the ski slopes. Use the tobogganing run or the signposted tobogganing slopes.

Skiing accidents

Please report the type and location of the accident to the nearest lift station or terminal, or contact the mountain rescue services directly.

Inspections and fraudulent use

Admission checks are carried out at the cable car valley terminals using automatic scanners. Please follow the instructions of the staff and use the ticket inspection machines properly. On-the-spot inspections take place in the ski area. Therefore, you should always carry your ski pass with you. Any incident of fraudulent use or bypassing of the scanners shall result in immediate confiscation of the ski pass. We reserve the right to report the offence to the police. Anyone caught in the inspection zones without a valid ski pass shall be required to pay a fine set at twice the allday ticket rate. A receipt showing that the fine has been paid can be used as a ski pass on the same day. Please note that under the Austrian railways liability act, only customers with a valid ski pass are covered for insurance purposes. Do not buy any ski passes from unauthorised vendors – such ski passes may be blocked! Furthermore, you are committing an offence by doing so! Kindly note that for admission control purposes a reference photo shall be taken of the lift pass holders when they pass through a turnstile equipped with a camera for the first time. Lift personnel shall compare this photographic image with photos taken each time the user passes through a turnstile equipped with a camera. The reference photo shall be deleted immediately upon expiry of the lift pass validity; other photos shall be deleted no later than 30 minutes after the user passes through a turnstile.
